## **Executives**

- **Producers**: Oversee the production process, managing finances, logistics, and ensuring the project is completed on time and within budget.
- Showrunners: Head writers and executive producers who oversee all aspects of a show's creative and operational direction.

### Creators

- **Video Editors**: Cut, arrange, and enhance footage to create a finished product, working closely with directors to shape the final narrative.

## **Behind The Scenes**

- Hair and Makeup Artists: Design and apply hairstyles, makeup, and prosthetics to enhance characters' looks for film or television productions.
- Wardrobe Stylists: Select and design clothing and costumes for actors, contributing to character development and visual storytelling.

#### On-Screen Talent

- Actors: Perform characters in front of the camera, embodying the roles scripted for them in films, television shows, or live performances.
- **Personalities**: Public figures, often with a strong media presence, who build a brand or persona and may appear in various entertainment or media outlets.
