WELCOME

Welcome to the 36th Annual GLAAD Media Awards, a celebration of the LGBTQ images and stories in media that change the world and accelerate acceptance for our community.

It is no coincidence that GLAAD is celebrating its 40th anniversary this year. We were founded in 1985 during the HIV epidemic, a time when our government refused to acknowledge the existence of our community, when we lost far too many friends and loved ones, and when misinformation about our lives dominated media and culture.

It wasn't political leaders or government institutions that saved us. It was us. Our community, our allies, our resilience. And that is exactly who will save us today.

The backlash we are witnessing today is a direct response to the success of our movement and the wave of cultural acceptance of LGBTQ people that resulted from our visibility. Over the past four decades, with your help, GLAAD has helped reshape culture, demanding and securing a rightful place in society for LGBTQ people. We won marriage equality and ended Don't Ask, Don't Tell. We have trans people leading on television, gracing magazine covers, and sharing their stories openly. Youth are feeling comfortable to come out more than ever, feeling seen and accepted. We flooded the zone with our visibility—and now, there is a dangerous price to that success.

This is our moment to reunite, meet people where they are at with messages that can move them, and commit to protecting LGBTQ acceptance like never before.

And that's exactly what GLAAD has been doing. This year, we've continued to hold the media at large accountable when misinformation about transgender people runs rampant. Through our GLAAD Media Institute, we meticulously track our inclusion across film, television, advertising, and gaming, and work year-round with industry leaders to increase LGBTQ visibility. Additionally, whether it be by appearing on the nation's leading Spanish-language news programs to contextualize the state of hate against LGBTQ people, or uplifting Black artists through our Equity in Media and Entertainment Initiative, GLAAD is also collaborating closely with communities of color to ensure that when our stories are told, those stories include diverse voices.

GLAAD's Local News and Rapid Response team is on the ground in Texas, Georgia, and beyond, working with local organizations to educate journalists and local influencers, and uplift powerful LGBTQ stories around HIV, faith, parenting, and more, while also reporting on local anti-LGBTQ hate and extremism through our ALERT desk program. Our Social Media Safety team has been a leading voice in opposition to big tech aligning itself with right-wing leaders. We are demanding protections for LGBTQ users online and working with up-and-coming platforms to ensure policies around hate speech and violence protect our community.

As we continue to fight for LGBTQ equality, let us take a moment to appreciate the over 300 nominees across film, TV, journalism, podcasts, music, video games, comic books, and more that joined us in the fight. By telling our stories in fair, accurate, and inclusive ways, you've sent a resounding message in support of a future where we all live with safety, dignity, and freedom, no matter the current landscape of LGBTQ support. As our opposition gets smarter, louder, and more organized, so do we. The GLAAD Media Awards exists to reflect those efforts, and to remind us of the most powerful tool the LGBTQ community has: our stories.

NOMINEE SELECTION PROCESS

GLAAD MEDIA AWARDS SELECTION PROCESS

The GLAAD Media Awards recognize and honor media for their fair, accurate and inclusive representations of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer community and the issues that affect our lives. They also fund GLAAD's work to amplify stories from the LGBTQ community that build support for LGBTQ acceptance. The GLAAD Media Awards have been held every year since 1990.

NOMINEE SELECTION

GLAAD monitors the media in order to identify nominees in 29 competitive English-language categories, and 4 competitive Spanish-language categories

In addition to year-round media monitoring, GLAAD issues a Call for Entries, encouraging media outlets to submit outstanding work for consideration. GLAAD may nominate a media project even if it is not submitted as part of the Call for Entries. GLAAD may nominate a media project even if it is not submitted as part of the Call for Entries.

ALL MEDIA PROJECTS WITH LGBTQ IMAGES ARE EVALUATED USING FOUR CRITERIA:

- ◆ Fair, Accurate, and Inclusive Representations – Rather than portraying the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer community using broad stereotypes, the project deals with the characters or themes in a fair, accurate, and multi-dimensional manner. Inclusive speaks to the importance of having the diversity of the LGBTQ community represented in our nominees.
- ◆ Boldness and Originality – The project breaks new ground by exploring LGBTQ subject matter in non-traditional ways, and handles the LGBTQ content in a fresh and original manner.
- ◆ Impact – The media project dramatically increases the cultural dialogue about LGBTQ issues, or reaches an audience that is not regularly exposed to LGBTQ images and issues. The project has significant cultural impact.
- ◆ Overall Quality – A project of extremely high quality adds significance to the images and issues portrayed and draws more viewers or readers to the material. Fair, accurate, and inclusive images may be less impactful if they are part of a poor-quality project.

As a non-profit organization that serves as a resource for media content creators to help them tell fair, accurate, and inclusive stories about the LGBTQ community, GLAAD may have consulted on the content of some of the GLAAD Media Award nominees. That consulting relationship does not influence which media projects receive a GLAAD Media Award nomination. Each nominee is judged solely on its merits and how well it fits the judging criteria for the GLAAD Media Awards, which may be found above.

SELECTION OF AWARD RECIPIENTS

GLAAD Media Awards voters contribute to the selection of award recipients in each category via online balloting. Voters are comprised of: GLAAD staff and board, GLAAD donors and volunteers, and selected media industry experts.

Award recipients are announced at the GLAAD Media Awards ceremonies.
